

In higher education, the Finnish Higher Education Evaluation Council (FINEEC) audits the quality assurance systems of Finnish higher education institutions (both universities and universities of applied sciences). FINEEC is an independent expert body assisting higher education institutions and the Ministry of Education and Culture in matters relating to evaluation. The Council Members represent universities, universities of applied sciences, students and world of work.

FINEEC is a member of several worldwide organizations related to quality assurance and adheres to their standards.

HAMK passed the most recent, *international*, quality audit in 2016. The audits are conducted every six years.


