

Bachelor's and Master's Degree education

Tailor-made degree education for the students coming from the countries outside European Union

- → 3,5 year Bachelor / undergraduate programme , implementation partly in home country, partly in Finland
- → upgrading or transfer education (3+1,5 or 3+1 model), from Diploma to Bachelor level
- \rightarrow joint programmes (2+2 model)
- → Master Programme in International Business Management (1 year+online)
- → Bachelor or Master Programme, tuition fee around 9000
 €/student/one academic year
